

## REFINISH DECKS WITH ARBORCOAT®

**Treat the wood**. Determine the wood you have to treat most appropriately.



Apply Benjamin Moore
Brighten and scrub the
product into the wood.
Power wash the
surface and let it dry
for 48 hours. Then

sand the deck with


80-grit sandpaper.




Weathered Wood:
Apply Benjamin Moore
Restore with a stiff
brush to clean the
dingy gray layer. Rinse
the deck down and
apply Benjamin Moore
Brighten and follow the
steps for New Wood.



Flaking and Peeling
Wood: Apply Benjamin
Moore Remove to get
rid of the old stain.
Rinse the deck down,
apply Benjamin Moore
Brighten and follow the
steps for New Wood.



2 Check the weather. Ensure the next 48 hours have a rain-free forecast.



Test the Color. Use a scrap of wood to make sure the stain is the color you want.



**Stain the wood.** Roll stain on the deck the full length of 2-3 boards at a time. Back brush to ensure proper coverage.



**5** Let the stain dry. Give it 48 hours to dry completely before heavy foot traffic.
